Proof of Concept Gas Conditioning Facility: FOR SALE

Agri-Waste Energy (AWE) is offering its Proof of Concept Gas Conditioning Facility (GCF) for sale.

The GCF was operated in 2007 -2008 to process biogas from dairy manure during Phase I of AWE's Western Wisconsin Renewable Natural Gas Dairy Basin Project (WWP).

Phase I of the WWP was a "Proof of Concept" demonstration of cleaning biogas produced in an anaerobic digester from dairy cow manure to meet specifications for injection into an interstate pipeline system.

The following overview describes the process developed by AWE for cleaning the biogas, compressing the cleaned gas, transporting the compressed gas, and injecting the Renewable Natural Gas into the Northern Natural Gas interstate pipeline system.

The Phase I demonstration was part of a Study conducted by the Gas Technology Institute during 2007-2008. That study, *Pipeline Quality Biomethane: North American Guidance Document for Interchangeability of Dairy Waste Derived Bionzethane* was published in 2009. The GCF was dismantled in 2009, and is in storage *at* Baldwin, Wisconsin. It will not he used in Phase 11 of the WWP because a much larger GCF is required.

AWE is offering the GFC for sale as a complete package the can be reassembled and operated for cleaning biogas to pipeline or NGV (natural gas vehicle) specifications.
